Orton-Gillingham Training

Based on the time-tested Orton-Gillingham method of reading instruction this thirty-six hour course focuses on the problems associated with language learning disabilities and the special instructional needs of individuals with dyslexia. This approach is based on the science of reading and provides instruction in the five essential components of effective reading programs as recommended by the National Reading Panel: phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary development, fluency, and comprehension strategies.

The Orton-Gillingham teaching approach will be demonstrated, taught, and practiced. Participants receive daily practice in lesson planning, teaching techniques, and the structuring, sequencing, and logic of the English language which is useful for all students. Participants will also have opportunities to use a variety of materials that are effective in working with students who are experiencing difficulties with reading, writing, and spelling and are in alignment with the Science of Reading.

The cost of the training is \$600 and may be paid in full or your spot may be held with a \$150 dollar deposit payable by check with the remainder due on June 1, 2024. Payment by Venmo is available on request. Materials included are: Tutor Reference Book, Reference Card Decks, and the Multisensory Teaching Kit.
